

INFORMATION ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA ON THE LINKEDIN PLATFORM

John Leggy Sp. z o.o.

Acting pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (OJ EU L 2016, No. 119, p. 1) (hereinafter referred to as the "GDPR"), we hereby inform you about the manner and purpose of processing your personal data on the LinkedIn platform, as well as about your rights arising from data protection regulations.

1. The Data Administrator of your personal data (hereinafter referred to as the Administrator) is John Leggy sp. z o.o., with its registered office in Warsaw, at ul. Bednarska 7, 00-310 Warsaw.
2. Independent of John Leggy, the administrator of personal data of LinkedIn users whose personal data is processed within the territory of the EU is LinkedIn Ireland Unlimited Company (the LinkedIn privacy policy is available at: https://www.linkedin.com/legal/privacy-policy?_l=pl_PL. Contact details for LinkedIn's Data Protection Officer are available at: <https://www.linkedin.com/help/linkedin/ask/TSO-DPO>).
3. Your personal data will be processed on the basis of the following legal grounds:
 - a) Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR, for the purpose of responding to your inquiries regarding our business offer, activities aimed at establishing cooperation, as well as other actions undertaken at your request;
 - b) Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR, for the purpose of operating, administering, and managing the profile on the LinkedIn platform, in accordance with the terms and conditions published by LinkedIn Ireland Unlimited Company; ensuring continuity of business communication; maintaining the organization's brand and image; promoting our own services (direct marketing); and conducting analyses related to the services offered, including quality assessments based on customer satisfaction surveys.
4. Recipients of your personal data may include:

- a) other users of the LinkedIn platform,
 - b) authorities and entities authorized under applicable legal provisions.
5. Your personal data will be processed on the LinkedIn platform for as long as our profile remains active or until you remove your data from our profile.
 6. Your personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making processes; however, it may be subject to profiling by LinkedIn Ireland Unlimited Company, in accordance with its privacy policy.
 7. Your data will not be transferred to third countries or international organizations; however, it will be subject to cross-border processing by LinkedIn Ireland Unlimited Company.
 8. You have the right to request access to your personal data, its rectification (correction), erasure—within the scope permitted by law—and restriction of processing. You also have the right to object to the processing of your personal data, provided that such processing is not necessary for the Data Administrator to fulfill a legal obligation and no other overriding legal grounds for processing exist.
 9. In connection with the processing of your personal data by the Data Administrator, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority, i.e. the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (ul. Stawki 2, 00-193 Warsaw).
